



Trash Guidelines

Republic Services is excited to partner with Berkley Grove as your waste and recycling service provider.

All TRASH must be placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. weekly on, Monday your collection day.

All RECYCLE must be placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. every other week on the same day as your trash collection day "A" week. (See calendar and guidelines for recycling on separate flyer).

ALL trash must be placed in the carts provided by Republic Services. Any trash outside of the cart will not be picked up.

What you may put out:

We can pick up standard household garbage, including food waste and cloth, shrubbery cuttings and broken down boxes as long as it is contained within your specially designed cart.

How to put it out:

Make sure your trash is placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day.

Republic will empty the cart using trucks that are equipped with an articulating arm. This arm will grasp and quickly empty the cart into the truck and then return the cart to its original position. All of this is done without the operator ever having to

leave the cab. This operation is performed quicker and safer than traditional manual collection methods.

- ⌚ Please make sure the cart has at least 4 feet of clearance from mailboxes, parked cars, etc. and that the handle is facing the residence.
- ⌚ Also, please make sure your cart lid is closed – this will keep any trash from spilling out into the roadway while dumping.

Heavy trash /Bulk items-Resident pays:

If you have items that do not fit in your cart we can arrange a bulk pick up for you. Residents receive 1 free bulk item per month any additional bulk items are \$20.00 per item, and Appliances are \$50.00 each. Extra bags can also be picked up at a cost of \$1.00 per bag paid for by the Resident. Please call 317-917-7300 48 hours in advance to make arrangements and payment will be taken at the time of the call.

Items we cannot accept

For safety and health reasons, we cannot pick up the following items:

- Demolition, construction, or discarded building materials, like drywall, roofing, brick, and wood

- Trees, large tree limbs, or tree stumps longer than 4ft in length (only limbs cut shorter than 4ft and tied and bundled will be taken)
- Brush and vegetation from building contractors, commercial tree trimmers, or lawn services
- Sod, fill dirt, and trash from contractor clearing, and other materials that require special handling
- Explosives, pathological and biological waste, radioactive material, ashes, and sand
- Automotive parts like engines, rear ends, springs, fenders, and seats
- Farm equipment, marine vessels, or any other major parts
- Septic, human, and animal waste (minimal amounts, like diapers and kitty litter, are OK)
- Effective January 1, 2011, Indiana households, public schools and small businesses will no longer be able to mix unwanted computer monitors, computers, televisions, printers, computer peripheral (i.e. keyboards, mice, etc.), DVD players, video cassette recorders or fax machines with municipal waste intended for disposal at a landfill or intended for disposal by burning or incineration.”

Refrigerators, air conditioners, and other items containing Freon require special handling and therefore we are unable to take them. Please call us for suggestions on how to dispose of these items.

Day. Trash collection will be delayed one (1) day for the remainder of the week, following the holiday.

Christmas tree pick up: Each household is allotted 1 Christmas tree pick up for the season.
