REPUBLIC TRASH & RECYCLING SCHEDULE 2021

<u>5G TOWER UPDATE....</u>

Verizon Wireless has officially re-started the process of submitting permits for 5G small cell structures in Fishers. The City is actively working with HOA's and property managers to meet with Verizon Wireless to provide feedback regarding the proposed locations of the 5G structures. The BG Board and concerned residents participated in a conference call on October 27, 2021 voicing concerns for this project going forward. While it was noted that Berkley Grove is not in favor of the 5G small cell structures, these proposed structures will be constructed in the utility easements. They will be black and have two lights. No timetable is available at this time. The Scheduled Resolutions for Board of Public Works and Safety will be presented December 13, 2021 for several neighborhoods including Berkley Grove.

Nickel Plate Trail Update

Paving has been completed on the portions of the trail between 146th Street and North Street, and South Street to 106th Street. These paved portions are now open for pedestrian and bicycle access. Motorized vehicles are prohibited unless required for accessibility purposes. Coordination and planning are underway with Indianapolis for the southern portion of the trail, between 96th Street and 106th Street.

Construction on the pedestrian tunnel beneath 116th Street and the surrounding downtown core is on schedule for completion by Spring 2022.
