**The Kirkendall Room** is located in the Red Brick Government Center. Walk in and turn left—meeting room is on the main level of the building.

The Annual Meeting will include elections of the following three Board of Director positions. Additionally, we are looking for a **Vice President** who would be responsible for handling Covenant Compliance. This would include covenant violations and maintain records on all rental property files to ensure Covenant Compliance. If you are interested in being nominated for any of these positions, please contact the current BOD.

The **President** is responsible for, but not limited to, organizing and running all neighborhood meetings, receiving and responding to residents who have questions and concerns, preparing updated neighborhood information for publication on the Berkley Grove website, distributing information to the board and/or residents via email or flyers, overseeing any special

committees, overseeing the email alert system, maintaining a current list of residents' contact information, organizing annual meeting, and giving board members a final approval for some projects.

The **Treasurer** is responsible for, but not limited to, payment of all invoices for the neighborhood via check or electronic bank payment, updating the budget for board meetings, drafting the annual budget (with the input/assistance of the board), checking the neighborhood mailbox at the Fishers Post Office, noticing and collecting POA dues annually, working with realtors and mortgage companies whether sold homes in Berkley Grove have paid their POA dues.

The **Secretary** is responsible for, but not limited to, recording and typing all board and annual meeting minutes, collecting and updating all resident contact information, arrange all logistics including meeting materials for board/committee meetings and annual meeting and filing the annual Business Entity Report with the State each year listing the current Board of Directors.

## REPUBLIC TRASH & RECYCLING SCHEDULE 2024

All bins must be placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. weekly on **MONDAY**, Berkley Grove's trash collection day. All TRASH must be placed in the Bins provided by Republic Services. Any trash outside of the trash bin (including leaf bags) will not be picked up.

RECYCLING is collected every other week on the same day as TRASH collection day (see back page for Complete 2024 Recycle Pickup Schedule).

The Berkley Grove contract is for TWO bins per household to be picked up each week. On Recycle Mondays, if you recycle, this would mean one recycle and one trash bin counts as the two bins.

Residents needing a third bin, will be billed individually by Republic Services for the extra bin.

Residents may also have one large item hauled away each month but must schedule directly with Republic Services.

When a bin becomes broken, contact Republic Services directly 317-917-7300. Let them know you are on the Berkley Grove POA contract. More information can be found at www.republicservices.com.

### MAILBOXES/MAILBOX POSTS

Currently, all Mailboxes/Mailbox Posts are provided by your POA Dues. The service provider will install these mailboxes and/or posts at the expense of the home owner by separate invoice. Orders are placed four times a year; March, June, September and December. The order form and guidelines are located on the website at www.berkleygrove.com/ forms.
